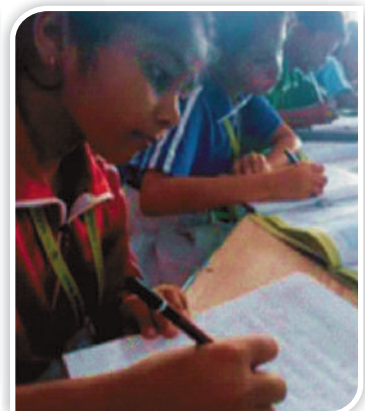
### Vrikshabhushan

### English Handwriting Competition

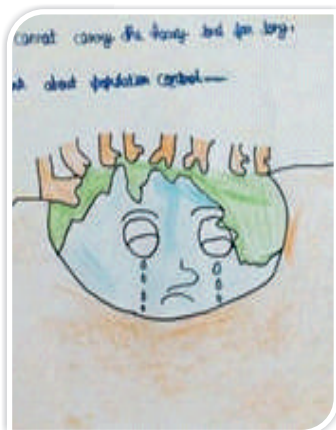

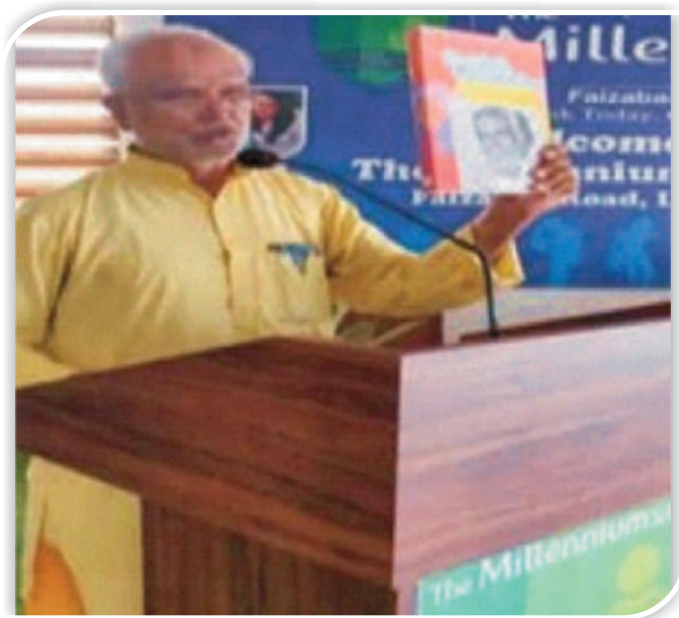

### Inter House English Debate Competition & Soft Board Decoration

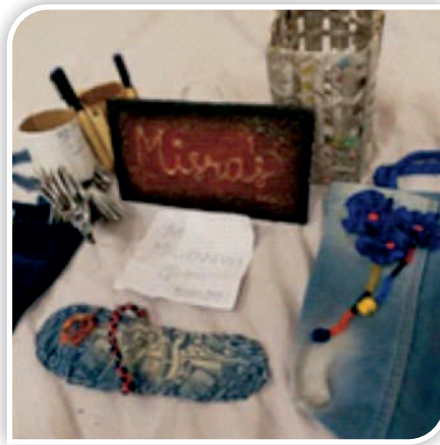

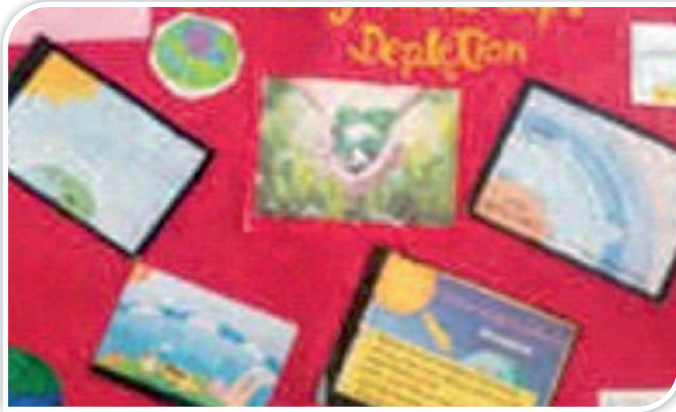




## Collage Competition & Extempore On World Ozone Day

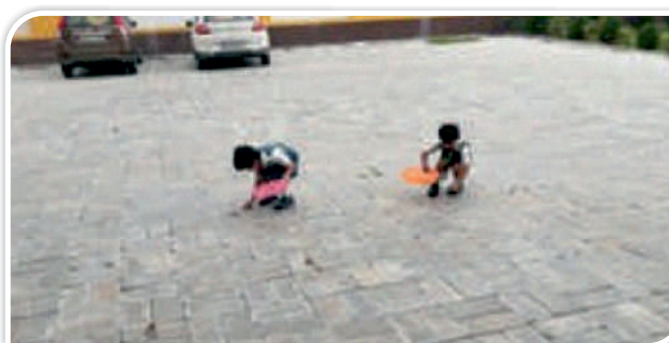
### Vijaydashmi Celebration
